Annual General Meeting, Annual Scientific Meeting, Induction Ceremony 9 October 2010

The AGM, ASM and Induction Ceremony for new members this year will be held on 9 October (Saturday) in the Kowloon Regal Hotel, Tsim Sha Tsui East.

The qualifying MRI written examination is scheduled on 11 December 2010. Deadline of application is 11 November 2010.

Donation of Education Fund

Surpluses from manufacturers' sponsorship for activities were donated to our professional societies, namely the Hong Kong Radiographers' Association, the Hong Kong Radiological Technologist Association and the Hong Kong Association of Radiation Therapists for research and educational purposes, each amount to \$30,000. Another \$60,000 was donated to the Hong Kong Polytechnic University for scholarships and radiography student activity, the total expenses on educational donation amount to \$150,000.

Mammography Training

The College is currently liaising with an equipment manufacturer to conduct a structured training course for local professionals. Insurance issue has yet to be sorted out before its implementation. Local examinations is being planned to be conducted in Hong Kong to save colleagues from having to make trips overseas for examinations.

Sponsorship for Overseas Conference Presentation

An amount of \$100,000 has recently been budgeted for conference presentation in 2010. Members with abstracts accepted for presentation at conferences are welcome to apply and the Council will consider each application discretely. The maximum sponsorship for each application will be \$10,000 and the approved amount will be based on the cost of the flight and conference registration fees subject to availability of funds at the time of application. Applicants are expected to contribute to their own accommodation expenses. Only one application per member will be considered in one calendar year. Applications are on first come first served basis and will only be considered when funds are still available for the year. Application forms can be downloaded from the College Website.
