Objective

The objective of the Certification Examinations is to provide a channel for Registered Radiographers who have attained the clinical experience and standards to be recognized as specialists in their respective specialty and be admitted as a Member of the Hong Kong College of Radiographers and Radiation Therapists (HKCRRT) in that area.

Entry Requirements

- ◆ Being a Radiographer registered with the Hong Kong Radiographers' Board
- ◆ 5 years of post-registration working experience in medical imaging
- ◆ A recognized Bachelor degree in medical imaging or related fields, or Professional Diploma in Diagnostic Radiography (PDDR) of the Hong Kong Polytechnic University, or equivalent.

Format of Certificate Examination

150 Multiple Choice Questions covering basic principles and clinical applications of the respective specialty.
